After the conclusion of the conference all presentations and video/sound clips will be distributed to all Undercover Farming role-players nationally and internationally.
- 4. While the Undercover Farming Expo does not cover speaker fees, presenters will be provided with lunch and refreshments on the day of their session. Additionally, they will have full access to the expo floor on their presentation day. <u>Should a speaker wish to attend the second day of the conference (on a non-speaking day), a nominal fee of R1 750.00 will apply to cover venue costs.</u>
- 5. Speakers are encouraged to confirm their participation as soon as possible, but no later than 1 July 2025, as only 12 speaker slots are available. Previous conferences have reached capacity, requiring organizers to turn away potential presenters.
- 6. Furthermore, the conference aims to foster engagement with future industry leaders by hosting BSc and MSc (final-year) students in the audience. During the 2025 Gauteng Undercover Farming Conference, these students actively participated in Q&A sessions, contributing to insightful and lively discussions that were highly appreciated by both speakers and delegates.
